- ¹ Must be out of the English Department. A full year course sequence with emphasis in <u>writing & comprehension</u>. Literature courses may not be accepted (ESL courses are <u>not accepted</u> for the English prerequisite).
- ² Statistics, fundamental, beginning, elementary algebra, or intermediate algebra are not acceptable. May list pre-calculus, calculus, geometry, or trigonometry to satisfy the prerequisite.
- ³ <u>Must</u> be out of Anatomy, Physiology, A&P, Biology, or Zoology Departments and **MUST INCLUDE AN ON-CAMPUS LAB**. Online/virtual labs will NOT be accepted.
- ⁴ Fundamental, introductory, organic, biochemistry, or principles are **not** acceptable.
- ⁵ **ONLY** General or Introductory accepted. **NO** exceptions.
- ⁶ **ONLY** General or Introductory accepted. **NO** exceptions.
- ⁷ Examples include Art, Music, Drama, Ethics, Philosophy, Religion, Ethnic Studies, Foreign Languages, and Speech. History is not recommended to satisfy this prerequisite.
- ⁸ All science prerequisites, including labs, must have been completed no more than seven years prior to the application deadline (i.e. courses completed in 2010 and later will be accepted for the Fall 2018 entering class).
