Application Materials Needed

• Online Application

- o \$60 non-refundable application fee made payable via credit card
- Scholarly Essay
 - o Will be submitted electronically though the online application
 - Compose your scholarly essay in a separate Word document and be sure to edit for spelling and grammar. It's always a good idea to have others proofread for spelling, grammar and clarity before submitting
 - Once your scholarly essay is ready, you can copy/paste within the respective section of the online application

• Curriculum Vitae

- o Please include all previous employers and academic institutions attended
- \circ $\;$ Will be submitted electronically within the online application

• Two Reference Forms

- To be completed by an employer or faculty member (non-relative)
- Forms will be sent electronically to your recommender based on the information you provide in your application
- Copies of national certification as family nurse practitioner and unencumbered licenses

• Official Transcripts of all schools attended

- All transcripts must be received including any undergraduate and/or graduate coursework that did not culminate in a degree
- WesternU prefers to accept transcripts electronically. These transcripts are considered official documents if they are sent directly from your school
- If you have completed any coursework outside of the US, you must get your coursework evaluated by either:
