

Next Steps

The following are important next steps for you to complete, if you haven't already. Please pay close attention to deadlines. Missing a deadline will result in the delay of your registration and/or financial aid, and in extreme cases, may result in the termination of your seat in the class of 2026.

Accept your offer of admission by submitting your \$500 non-refundable acceptance deposit. You will find instructions for submitting the deposit on your Application Status Page. • Your acceptance deposit is due on the date indicated on your offer letter.
 Official Fall and Spring transcript(s) showing the satisfactory completion of all coursework & degrees. Fall transcripts are March 31, 2022. If official Spring transcripts are not available by June 1, 2021, please submit an unofficial grade report (found on the Admitted Student Website) for each Spring course in progress the week of June 1, 2022, or a letter from the registrar for each degree in progress. All final official transcripts must be received by June 15, 2022 prior to registration.
The following must be received no later than June 1, 2022
 All prerequisite courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or higher by the end of the spring semester/quarter prior to matriculation. Please contact us immediately if you learn that you received a questionable grade so we may discuss how this affects your admission status. Notify us if your plans change and you are unable to enroll in a course you listed as planned. This is important so we can confirm that new courses meet our requirement.
